## FAITH ACTION NETWORK ORGANIZER POSITION

Faith Action Network (FAN) is a statewide interfaith 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization through which thousands of people and over 127 faith communities across Washington State partner for the common good.

Since its inception 6 years ago, 3 full-time staff (2 co-directors and an administrative coordinator), interns, and volunteers have built and supported the organization. Seeking even greater impact on public policy, FAN is hiring an additional full-time staff person to increase capacity to educate, train, organize, and advocate while better engaging and utilizing FAN's existing network of faith communities, partner organizations, and individuals. ### A successful Organizer will:

- Equip, grow, and strengthen FAN's Network of Advocating Faith Communities (NAFC's), Legislative District Coordinators (LDC's), and faith leaders to mobilize their constituencies to be more effective advocates.
- Advance FAN's priorities in strategic legislative and congressional districts by working with FAN's network and coalition partners to organize issue and candidate forums, meetings with elected officials, and more.
- Integrate organizing efforts with the state legislative session to help pass or defeat bills important to FAN and its policy partners.
- Mobilize increased participation in Interfaith Advocacy Day, FAN's four regional spring summits, and fall cluster gatherings.
- Work with FAN's Issue Working Groups when appropriate for organizing purposes.
- Promote FAN's visibility and social change impact with faith communities, partners, and the broader public across the state (through in-person, social media, story-sharing efforts).
- Be an active team player in the FAN office, doing whatever it takes to advance FAN's mission.

### Qualifications:

- Organizing experience and comfort working with diverse faith communities and secular groups on social justice issues. Two years of successful organizing experience preferred.
- Ability to accept, embrace, and relate to diverse faith traditions and cultural / ethnic communities.
- Excellent organizational, written, and verbal communications skills.
- Experience and skill working in a team environment and engaging volunteers.
- Comfort and proficiency with database use/tracking, social networking tools, and MS Office Suite programs.
- Demonstrated knowledge and interest in Washington State political dynamics and policy issues preferred.
- Ability to work evenings and weekends as needed.
- Valid Washington State Driver's License and use of an insured personal vehicle as necessary for required travel (with usage reimbursement).
- All relevant education and experience will be considered.

**Salary range: \$40,000-\$44,000 DOE plus health insurance and paid vacation and sick leave.**

The position is a full-time, exempt position, located in Seattle, Washington. Organizer will report to and be supervised by the Co-Directors of FAN.
