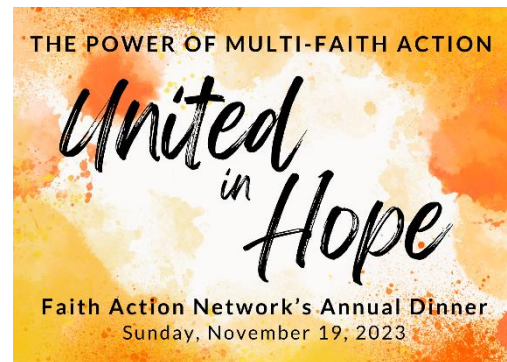
A Partnership for the Common Good
