

# A Broad Coalition Supports the ReWRAP Act (HB 2049)



The ReWRAP Act proposes an extended producer responsibility (EPR) program for packaging and paper products. A broad coalition of businesses, environmental organizations, local governments, and residents support the bill. EPR would:

1. Provide curbside recycling services to all Washington residents that currently have garbage service;
2. Create a statewide list of recyclable materials; and
3. Shift the cost burden of recycling from residents and local governments to producers of packaging and paper products.

As a result:

1. Recycling rates will increase 26% by 2032;
2. 1,650 jobs will be created across the state, and
3. Producers will be incentivized to reduce their use of paper and packaging products.
