
A Broad Coalition Supports the ReWRAP Act (HB 2049)





- 1. Provide curbside recycling services to all Washington residents that currently have garbage service;
- 2. Create a statewide list of recyclable materials; and
- 3. Shift the cost burden of recycling from residents and local governments to producers of packaging and paper products.

As a result:

- 1. Recycling rates will increase 26% by 2032;
- 2. 1,650 jobs will be created across the state, and
- 3. Producers will be incentivized to reduce their use of paper and packaging products.


